

PET COMFORT TIPS

Most pets know that loud noises like thunderstorms & fireworks are no big deal, but that doesn't mean they all do. Here are some suggestions related to noise.

Head Inside

Consider placing pets indoors in a safe, secure area.

Reduce Exterior Noise

Close windows, doors, & window treatments. This can also reduce bright flashes.

Add Ambient Noise

Turn on a favorite television show or playlist.

Identification

Ensure pets have accurate ID & contact info on them.

Training & Empowerment

Play videos that include loud, unexpected noises like thunderstorms & fireworks year-round. Start at a low volume & slowly increase it over time. Show them those noises are no big deal by ignoring them & going about your day. If your pet shows signs of anxiety, reduce the volume & start there next time.

Consult Your Veterinarian

If you know or suspect your pet is noise sensitive, talk to your vet. They have extensive resources!
